NOTICE

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR ON THE 25th DAY OF MAY, 1962, DEPUTED THE MINISTER CHARGED WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR PUBLIC WORKS TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWER SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE TO THIS NOTICE CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATION:—

That the delegation of power mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor.
