And Whereas the Royal Bank of Canada is willing to enter into an Agreement to establish on behalf of the Government an irrevocable Letter of Credit not exceeding the sum of US\$100,000 together with any interest due thereon in favour of Parsons and Whittemore Inc., to pay for onehalf of the estimated cost of the study:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Mational Assembly do authorise the Government to enter an Agreement with the Royal Bank of Canada for the abovementioned purpose.
