PUBLIC BUSINESS

BILL - Second Reading

1. The Minister of Finance to move the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUE FROM THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE SUM NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE (NOT OTHERWISE LAWFULLY CHARGED ON THE CONSOLIDATED FUND) OF GUYANA FOR THE YEAR ENDING THE 31ST DECEMBER, 1968, ESTIMATES WHEREOF HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, AND FOR APPROPRIATION OF THAT SUM FOR SPECIFIED PURPOSES, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE CONSTITUTION.

7. The Minister of Labour and Social Security to move the following motion:

WHEREAS the International Labour Conference at its Fiftieth Session in Geneva during June, 1966, adopted the following Conventions and Recommendations:-

- (i) Fishermen's Competency Certificates Convention 1966 (No. 125)
- (ii) Accommodation of Crews (Fishermen) Convention 1966 (No. 126)
- (iii) Vocational Training (Fishermen) Recommendation 1966 (No. 126)
- (iv) Co-operatives (Developing Countries) Recommendation 1966 (No. 127);

AND WHEREAS Guyana, as a member of the International Labour Organisation, is required to bring these Conventions and Recommendations to the attention of the National Assembly within one year and in no case later than eighteen months;

AND WHEREAS the Conventions and Recommendations were laid in the National Assembly on the 15th of December, 1967, in Sessional Paper No. 3/1967;

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly adopt the conclusions contained in Sessional Paper No. 3/1967 on International Labour Conventions and Recommendations adopted on 26th June, 1966, at the Fiftieth Session of the International Labour Conference.
