That notwithstanding the decision of this Council not to enter immediately into regotiations with the West Indies Federation with a view to British Guiana joining the West Indies Federation, this Council recommends to Government that it approaches the West Indies Federation with a view to discussing economic relations between this Colony and the West Indies Federation, and to explore the possibility of British Guiana being invited to send a representative with the West Indies team to Canada.
