MOTION

Item 1 - MR. JAI NARINE SINGH'S MOTION RECOMMENDING THE WITHDRAWAL OF PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT TO THE BRITISH WEST INDIAN AIR-WAYS.

Council resumed the debate on the following motion:-

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Council recommends to Government the withdrawal of preferential treatment to the British West Indian Airways and the establishment of Atkinson Field as a port of call for as many airlines as may wish to call there.

The Minister of Communications and Works concluded his speech.

Thereafter, Mr. Tasker spoke to the motion.

Mr. Gajraj then moved the following amendment:

Deletion of all the words after the word "recommends" in the first line and the <u>substitution</u> therefor of the words "that, after the expiration of the current agreement, no preferential treatment be given to British West Indian Airways without proper and and adequate safeguards."

After Mr. Hubbard and Dr. Jagan had spoken, Mr. Jai Narine Singh in his reply accepted Mr. Gajraj's amendment.

The motion, as amended, was then put and carried.

Item 2 - BRITISH GULANA RICE PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION (AMENDMENT), BILL, 1960 - Bill No. 5/1960.

At the request of the Minister of Natural Resources, and with Council's consent, further consideration of this Bill was deferred.
