ORAL ASKING AND ANSWERING OF QUESTIONS

Question No. 12

 $\underline{\text{Mr. Burnham}}$ asked the Financial Secretary the following question:

QUESTION: Why are the rates of import duty on imported soap 15 and 30 per cent and those on soap powders, soap flakes and detergents 6 and 12 per cent?

The Financial Secretary gave the following reply:

ANSWER:

The import duty on soap in bars, slabs, tablets or cakes was fixed at the high rates of 15 and 30 per cent to give a fair measure of tariff protection to the local industry which is able to supply fully and satisfactorily the country's needs of this form of cleansing material.

The lower duty of 6 and 12 per cent is more appropriate for imports of detergents and of soap in powder or flake form, for which there is no adequate supply or substitute from local manufacture.

That this Council recommends to Government that the Government Housing Estates be brought within the provisions of the Rent Restriction Ordinance, Chapter 186.
