- 1. The Minister of Finance to move the fo lowing motion:
  - BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Legislative Assembly pproves of the payment of additional cost-of-living allowan es with effect from lst January, 1961, to supplement ose now in force, to Government pensioners (including t achers), who retired prior to lst January, 1961, and to Widows' and Orphans' pensioners who were awarded pensio based on pre-1961 contributions, as follows: (i) <u>To ensioners excludi</u> ensioners who retired f

> Cost-of-living allowances t rates equal to the difference between the current pension and the pension payable o the equivalent revised salary at 1st Jan ry, 1961.

- (ii) <u>To all other pensioners</u> ( cluding Widows' and Orphans' pensioners)
  - (a) 10% of "gross" pensio (basic and cost-of-living allowa e, if any) on "gross" pensions not exceeding \$1,200 per annum.
  - (b) \$120 per annum on "gr s" pensions (basic plus cost-of-1 ing allowance, if any) exceeding \$1, per annum;

## AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Widows' and Orphans' - nsions awarded <u>after</u> lst January, 1954, but based on pre 1954 contributions, be increased by a cost-of-living allowance so as to bring the gross pensions payable f m lst January, 1961, in line with gross pensions b sed on the same contributions but awarded <u>before</u> 1st January, 1954.
