WHEREAS Article 197 A (5) of the Constitution provides that
Disciplined Forces Commissions may be constituted by the National Assembly.

AND WHEREAS on the 16th May, 2003, the National Assembly passed Resolution Number 21 approving the establishment and terms of reference of a Disciplined Forces Commission.

AND WHEREAS the Disciplined Forces Commission has been constituted and has commenced its work.

BE IT RESOLVED:

that the National Assembly authorizes the Disciplined Forces Commission to take all steps and make all decisions in connection with the administrative aspects of the work of the Disciplined Forces Commission, including but not limited to, the establishment of a Secretariat, to enable it to discharge its mandate as provided for in the aforesaid Resolution.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

that the National Assembly approves all such steps already taken by the Disciplined Forces Commission in connection with the aforesaid.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

that Mr. Gino Peter Persaud, State Council attached to the Attorney General's Chambers, be and is hereby appointed Secretary to the Disciplined Forces Commission.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

that a quorum shall consist of the Chairman and two Members, one of whom was nominated by the President and one of whom was nominated by the Leader of the Opposition.
