2. <u>INCREASE IN OLD AGE PENSIONS</u>

The Vice-President, Public Welfare, to move the following motion:

WHEREAS section 8(1) and (2) of the Old Age Pensions Act, Chapter 36:03, now provides as follows -

- "8. (1) The amount of pension payable to any person under and in accordance with this Act shall be -
 - (a) in the case of a person ordinarily resident in Georgetown, thirty dollars per month;
 - (b) in the case of a person ordinarily resident elsewhere in Guyana than in Georgetown, thirty dollars per month.

(2) The National Assembly may, from time to time, by resolution (which shall be published in the <u>Gazette</u>), very the amounts and any residential qualification prescribed by subsection (1) with effect from the date of the resolution or such earlier or later date as is specified in that behalf in the resolution.";

AND WHEREAS it is proposed that Old Age Pensions payable under paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 8(1) of the Act be increased from thirty dollars per month to forty-five dollars per month with effect from 1st January, 1981:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assombly in accordance with section 8(2) of the Act approve that the amounts prescribed under paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 8(1) of the Act be varied from thirty dollars per month to forty-five dollars per month, with effect from the 1st January, 1981.
