WHEREAS the Delhi Declaration on Principles for a Nuclear Free and Non-Violent World made by Rajiv Gandhi, Prime Minister of the Republic of India and Mikhail Gorbachyov, General Secretary of the CPSU Central Committee, in New Delhi on November 27, 1986 included ten principles, as follows:-

- (2) Human life must be recognised as supreme;
- (3) Non-wielence should be the basis of community life;
- (4) Understanding and trust must replace fear and suspicion;
- (5) The right of every state to political and economic independence must be recognised and respected;
- (6) Resources being spent on armaments must be channelled towards social and economic developments;
- (7) Conditions must be guaranteed for the individualis harmonious development;
- (8) Mankind's material and intellectual potential must.
 be used to solve global problems;
- (9) The "balance of terror" must give way to comprehensive international security;
- (10) A nuclear weapon free and non-violent world requires specific and immediate action for disarmenent;
