# \*4. INCOME TAX RELIEFS

Cde. Reepu Daman Persaud to move the following motion:

WHEREAS the income tax laws and regulations made no provision for certain dependent relatives over the age of 16 who are unmarried, have no children and are unemployed, even though they are dependent on the tax-payer for living expenses;

AND WHEREAS there are many single-parent families, where one person is the sole provider, but no special tax allowances are made for this human situation;

AND WHEREAS many persons have savings in co-operative societies and credit unions;

BE IT RESOLVED:

That - (i) allowances be given for dependent relatives over the age of 16 once they are unmarried and unemployed;

> (ii) an additional personal allowance be given heads of one-parent families, and

(iii) income tax relief be given on savings in co-operative societies and credit unions.
