IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 4 OF THE CONSUMPTION TAX ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:-

1. This Order, which amends the Consumption Tax Order*,
