IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 2 OF THE PENSIONS (PRESIDENT, PARLIAMENTARY AND SPE-CIAL OFFICES) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:---

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensions (President, Parliamentary and Special Offices) (Designation) Order 1991 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 25th February, 1986.

2. The office of the Head of the Presidential Secretariat in the Office of the President is hereby designated as a specified qualifying office for the purposes of the Act.

3. Notwithstanding clause 2, service in the office designated by that clause shall be service as a legislator for the purposes of the Act only if -

- (i) that service was preceded by service of the holder thereof in such other office as would qualify to be reckoned as service as a legislator for the purposes of the Act;
- (ii) the holder of the office so designated relinquishes any claim he may have under any other written law for'pension or'other superannuation benefits in respect of the period of his service in that office.
