THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988

(No. 21 of 1988)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, AS APPLIED TO GUYANA TRANSPORT SERVICES LIMITED UNDER SECTION 66 OF THAT ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Transport Services Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 1991 and shall come into operation on 20th June, 1991. Citation and commencement.

2. In this Order — Interpretation.
 - (a) “appointed day” means the day on which this Order comes into operation;

 - (b) “Company” means the Guyana Transport Services Limited, being a company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act and the controlling interest in which is vested in the State. Cap. 89:01

3. The item of immovable property of the State described in the Schedule, and which is at present in the possession of the Company, is hereby vested in the Company. Vesting of property of the State in the Company
