IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Remuneration of Holders) (No. 3) Order 1991 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1991.
