IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 8 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988, AS APPLIED TO GUYANA TRANSPORT SERVICES LIMITED BY NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66 OF THAT ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

(a) "Agreement" means the agreement made on the 28th day of June, 1991 between the Company and the Purchaser;

(b) "Company" means the Guyana Transport Services Limited, being a company incorporated in Guyana under the Companies Act and the controlling interest in which is vested in the State;

(c) "Property" means the property described in the Schedule, being property belonging to the Company;

(d) "Purchaser" means Mr. Ragnauth Dewnarayan of lot 8, Crabwood Creek, Grant 1651, Corentyne, Guyana.

3. Pursuant to the Agreement and subject to the terms and conditions specified therein, the Property, partial possession of which has already been given to the Purchaser, is hereby transferred to him.
