# THE LABOUR ORDINANCE

(Chapter 103)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Rural Cinema Employees) (Amendment) Order, 1966, and shall be construed and read as one with the Minimum Wages (Rural Cinema Employees) Order, 1959\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.
- 2. Article 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the full stop at the end of the definition of the expression "rural area" and the addition thereafter of the following —

"and the Mackenzie area situate on the right bank of the Demerara River commencing from the Kara-Kara River and extending up the left bank of the Kara-Kara River to the Shibaru Creek thence up the left bank of the Shibaru Creek to its source and thence in a straight line due west to the right bank of the Demerara River at Three Friends."

3. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the schedule thereto of the schedule to this Order.

### SCHEDULE

Category of Worker	Minimum Wage Rates
Operators	
First	44c. per hour
Trainee General Staff	40c. per hour
Under 18 years	24c. per hour
18 years and over	38c. per hour
Cashiers	42c. per hour
Clerical Assistants	40c. per hour
Guards	30c. per hour

The minimum rate of wages payable to a person employed during any period of time mentioned in this schedule in more than one category of work set out above in respect of which different minimum rates of wages are set out, shall be the highest of such rates.

The minimum rate of wages payable to a person employed in any of the above categories of work for any shorter period of time than the appropriate period set out above shall be the appropriate minimum rate of wages set out above in respect of the last mentioned period.
