ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers Order, 1966.
2. The Minister for the time being responsible for friendly societies is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor the powers conferred on the Governor by sections 3 (d), 4, 7 (2), 10, 15 (2), 25 (5), 26 (f), 29A (1), 45, 47 (a) (11) and (111), 47 (b), 62 (2) and 63 (3) of the Friendly Societies Ordinance, subject however to the following conditions and qualifications —
 - (a) that the delegation of the powers effected by this Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by the Governor;
 - (b) that the exercise of any power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any directions, either general or particular, which the Governor may from time to time give in that respect.
