MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959.
(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SUBSECTION (1) OF SECTION 17 OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Aberdeen and Three Friends) Order, 1966.

2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

An area of land situate on the Essequibo Coast of the County of Essequibo and bounded as follows :—
