THE UNITED KINGDOM FORCES (JURISDICTION OF COLONIAL COURTS) ORDER, 1965.

- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON HIM BY SUB-SECTION (5) OF SECTION 2 OF THE UNITED KINGDOM FORCES (JURISDICTION OF COLONIAL COURTS) ORDER, 1965 (HEREIN-AFTER REFERRED TO AS THE PRINCIPAL ORDER) AND ALL OTHER POWERS HIM THEREUNTO ENABLING THE GOVERNOR HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the United Kingdom Forces (Jurisdiction of Colonial Courts) (Prescribed Member of a Civilian Component of Her Majesty's Forces) Order, 1966, and shall come into operation forthwith.
- 2. For the purpose of subsection (5) of section 2 of the Principal Order, a person is a prescribed member of a civilian component of any of Her Majesty's forces if, and is not qualified to be such a member unless
 - (A) he is a person who is subject to the jurisdiction of a service court by virtue of the nature of his service or employment (not being service or employment as a member of Her Majesty's forces) and in respect of whom a certificate has been issued by or on behalf of the Officer Commanding Her Majesty's forces in British Guiana
 - (a) that he has been engaged for such service or employment in a place outside British Guiana; or
 - (b) that he has been engaged for such service or employment in British Guiana upon terms that render him liable for duty outside British Guiana; or
 - (c) that he has been engaged for such service or employment in British Guiana and is a dependent of (1) a member of Her Majesty's forces; or (2) a person who has been engaged for such service or employment in a place outside British Guiana or (3) a person who has been so engaged in British Guiana upon terms that render him liable for duty outside British Guiana, as the case may be; or

B) he is a person who is subject to the jurisdiction of a service court and in respect of whom a certificate has been issued by or on behalf of the Officer Commanding Her Majesty's forces in British Guiana that he is a dependent of a member of Her Majesty's forces or of a person who is a prescribed member of a civilian component under sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph.
