

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE UNITED KINGDOM FORCES (JURISDICTION OF COLONIAL COURTS) ORDER, 1965.

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON HIM BY SUBSECTION (5) OF SECTION 2 OF THE UNITED KINGDOM FORCES (JURISDICTION OF COLONIAL COURTS) ORDER, 1965 (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE PRINCIPAL ORDER) AND ALL OTHER POWERS HIM THEREUNTO ENABLING THE GOVERNOR HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the United Kingdom Forces (Jurisdiction of Colonial Courts) (Prescribed Member of a Civilian Component of Her Majesty's Forces) Order, 1966, and shall come into operation forthwith.

2. For the purpose of subsection (5) of section 2 of the Principal Order, a person is a prescribed member of a civilian component of any of Her Majesty's forces if, and is not qualified to be such a member unless —

- (A) he is a person who is subject to the jurisdiction of a service court by virtue of the nature of his service or employment (not being service or employment as a member of Her Majesty's forces) and in respect of whom a certificate has been issued by or on behalf of the Officer Commanding Her Majesty's forces in British Guiana —
- (a) that he has been engaged for such service or employment in a place outside British Guiana; or
 - (b) that he has been engaged for such service or employment in British Guiana upon terms that render him liable for duty outside British Guiana; or
 - (c) that he has been engaged for such service or employment in British Guiana and is a dependent of (1) a member of Her Majesty's forces; or (2) a person who has been engaged for such service or employment in a place outside British Guiana or (3) a person who has been so engaged in British Guiana upon terms that render him liable for duty outside British Guiana, as the case may be; or

(B) he is a person who is subject to the jurisdiction of a service court and in respect of whom a certificate has been issued by or on behalf of the Officer Commanding Her Majesty's forces in British Guiana that he is a dependent of a member of Her Majesty's forces or of a person who is a prescribed member of a civilian component under sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph.
