THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 162).

UNDER SECTION 13(1) OF THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Registration District (Revision of Limits of Divisions) Order, 1966, and shall come into operation on the 25th day of May, 1966.
- 2. The limits of the divisions of the North Western Registration of Births and Deaths District shall be as set out in the schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

The North Western Registration of Births and Deaths District — No. 1 Division — includes the Waini and Barama Rivers and their tributaries. No. 2 Division — the Moruca River and its tributaries. No. 3 Division — the Barima River and its tributaries, from but exclusive of Koriabo to and inclusive of Arakaka together with that portion of the Kaituma River from the right bank Sebai River to its source. No. 4 Division — the right bank Amakura River and its tributaries from the boundary line between British Guiana

- and Venezuela to its source, together with the Barima River and its tributaries from the boundary line between British Guiana and Venezuela to and inclusive of Koriabo save and except that portion of the Kaituma River from the right bank Sebai River to its source.
- No. 5 Division the Barima River and its tributaries from but exclusive of Arakaka to its source.
