MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment and Imposition) Order, 1967.
- 2. Part I of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance is hereby amended
 - (a) by the substitution for the item numbers referred to in the first column of the first schedule to this Order, and for the classifications, units of quantity and rates of import duty appearing against those numbers in the said Part, of such item numbers, classifications, units of quantity and rates of import duty as are set out in the second column of the said schedule against such references, respectively;
 - (b) by the substitution, for the rates of import duty set out in the said Part against the item numbers and classifications mentioned in the first and second columns of the second schedule to this Order, of the rates of import duty set out in the third column of the said schedule against the same, respectively;
 - (c) by the deletion of item 099-09.11.
- 3. There shall be payable on all imported goods classified in Part I of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance (as hereby amended) under any group or item number mentioned in the third schedule to this Order
 - (a) additional duty of five per centum of their value in the case of goods whereon the rates of import duty according to the preferential and general tariffs set out in the said Part do not exceed twenty and forty per centum, respectively;
 - (b) additional duty of ten per centum of their value in the case of other goods.
