ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 191).

UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Emergency) Order, 1967.
2. The Sea Defence Board is hereby ordered to take such immediate action and perform such works as may in the opinion of the Board be necessary to avert or mitigate inundation by the sea of the land lying between the west sideline of Plantation Zeelugt and the east sideline of Plantation The Best, West Coast, Demerara, in the Sea Defence District No. 4.
