THE AIR NAVIGATION (INVESTIGATION OF ACCIDENTS) REGULATIONS, 1952.

(No. 19 of 1952)

WHEREAS I have deemed it expedient to hold public inquiries into the causes and circumstances of the two air navigation accidents occurring within Guyana on the 7th day of May, 1967, and the 23rd day of May, 1967, respectively.

NOW THEREFORE under Regulation 10 of the Air Navigation (Investigation of Accidents) Regulations, 1952, and by virtue and in exercise of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby direct that public inquiries be held into the causes and circumstances of —

- (a) the accident to Cessna 172 Aircraft VP-GBF at Old England, Demerara River, Guyana on the 7th day of May, 1967;
- (b) the accident to Cessna 185 Aircraft VP-GCN near Aramai Island, Mazaruni River, Guyana on 23rd May, 1967.
