THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE, (Chapter 71).

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Glasford (Transfer of Insurance Policy) Order, 1967.
- 2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the policy of insurance in the sum of two thousand dollars effected on the life of CECIL DUNCAN GLASFORD with the Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society under the said Ordinance in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister of Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policy of insurance to the said CECIL DUNCAN GLASFORD and his wife PALMYRA EMILY GLASFORD and pay over to them the proceeds of such policy of insurance and any increase thereon.
