THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Amendment) Order, 1967, and shall be construed and read as one with the Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (No. 1) Order, 1960*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. The Principal Order as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the deletion from the schedule thereto of the Countries specified in the schedule to this Order.

3. The Animals Diseases (Prohibition of Importation) (Amendment) Order, 1963**, is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Owing to the presence of foot and mouth disease in the United Kingdom it has been considered necessary to prohibit the importation of carcasses of meat from England, Scotland and Wales.
