ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958.

(No. 34 of 1958)

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 3) Order, 1967, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.

2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby further amended —

- (a) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 012—01—
012—02.1 Beef — salted
- (b) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 025—01—
031—02 Fish—salted
- (c) by the substitution of the following item for item 054—02—
“054—02 Beans and peas, dry (excluding garbanzos, chick peas and split peas.)”
- (d) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 054—02—
054—02.1 Peas — split
- (e) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 054—09—
054—09.2 Onions
- (f) by the insertion of the following item immediately after item 716—13.2.—
841—02.1—Vests for men and boys
841—02.2—Vests for women and girls
841—03.1—shirts for men and boys
841—03.2—shirts for women and girls

841—04.1—Pyjamas and other nightwear for men and boys

841—04.2—Pyjamas and other nightwear for women and
girls

841—05.1—shirts for men and boys

841—05.2—shirts for women and girls

(g) by the insertion of the following items immediately after
item 899—04—

899—11.9—other (Polythene bags only).
