UNDER SECTION 96 OF THE POLICE ORDINANCE, 1957, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Rural Constables (Fees and Allowances) Order, 1968.
- 2. Whenever any rural constable is called out or employed on full-time service with the Police Force he shall, instead of being paid at the rates specified in such items of the schedule to the Police Ordinance, 1957,* as are referred to in the first column of the schedule to this Order, be paid at the rates specified in the second column of the last mentioned schedule opposite such references, respectively.
