ORDER

THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958,

(No. 33 of 1958.)

UNDER THE PROVISO TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shops Hours (Special Provision) Order, 1968.

2. Every shop, other than a restaurant, parlour or cookshop, barber's or hairdresser's establishment, within the urban area (as defined in section 2 of the Shops (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1958,) the occupier of which notifies the Commissioner of Police not later than the 13th day of March, 1968, that the shop will be open during the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on the 14th March, 1968, may be open during the said hours on the date so notified.

3. Every shop, other than a restaurant, parlour or cookshop, barber's or hairdresser's establishment as aforesaid may be open during the hours of 7.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on the 14th March, 1968.
