THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963*, and any Order amending the same.

2.
