**THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 34 of 1958)**

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.
2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby further amended—
 - (a) by the substitution of a comma for the semicolon appearing against item 051-06; and
 - (b) by the insertion of the following against item 051-06—"pears (fresh);".
