ORDER

Made Under

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,
(CHAPTER 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Poultry Carcasses (Conditions of Importation) (Amendment) Order, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Poultry Carcasses (Conditions of Importation) Order, 1965,* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and all amendments thereto.
2. Paragraph 6 of the Principal Order is hereby amended —
 - (a) by the substitution of a colon for the full stop; and
 - (b) by the addition of the following proviso thereto — “Provided that viscera (or any part thereof) may be imported from any country specified in the schedule to this Order if the principal Government Veterinary Surgeon commonly called the Principal Veterinary Officer, is satisfied on evidence submitted to him that the importation is not likely to cause the introduction of disease into Guyana.”
