THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE

(Chapter 179)

UNDER SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN THE EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Multilateral School) Order, 1968.
2. The proposed construction of a multilateral school on the land described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or other wise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or of part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

All that piece or parcel of land marked "R" containing an area of 21.02 (twenty-one decimal nought two) acres being a portion of two pieces of land namely:—

- (a) a piece of Land measuring 1 (one) acre 3 (three) rods, 29 (twenty-nine) poles in area part of Plantation Wilhelmina, as show tinted pink on a plan by C. L. Ridley, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 31st August, 1923 and
- (b) that piece of land part of Plantation Bygeval or Vygeval known as and sometimes called "Old Race Course" or Chelsea Village, the said Plantation Wilhelmina and Bygeval being situated on the east bank of the Mahaica Creek on the east sea coast of the County of Demerara, Guyana, the said piece of land being shown and defined on a plan by S. S. R. Insanally, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 20th September, 1961, and deposited in the Deeds Registry on 24th November, 1961.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order declares the proposed construction of a multilateral school on the eastern portion of the Old Chelsea Park Race Course, Mahaica to be a public work and authorises the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer to enter upon the said land (which is described in the schedule to the Order) in order that he may carry out certain preliminary work with a view to the acquisition of the said land.
