# THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958 (No. 34 of 1958)

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1969 and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and all amendments thereto.
- 2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the articles of foodstuff numbered 5, 6, 9, 10, 12 and 17, respectively.
  - 3. The Orders specified in the Third Schedule hereto, are hereby revoked.
- 4. The particulars specified in relation to the articles of foodstuff listed in Part A and Part B, respectively, of the First Schedule to this Order, shall be the maximum prices at which those articles of foodstuff shall be sold in those areas of Guyana as defined in the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - 5. This Order shall come into operation forthwith.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

Parts of Guyana to which this Order applies -

- 1. That part of the North West District situated within thirty miles of the Atlantic Ocean; and elsewhere in Guyana, that part situated within twenty-five miles of the Atlantic Ocean.
- 2. (i) The area within five miles of either bank of the Berbice River to the south of that part of Guyana defined in paragraph 1 and extending as far south as the junction of the Kibilibiri River with the Berbice River.
  - (ii) That part of the Watershed between the Berbice River and the Demerara River known as the Ituni Settlement of the Demerara Bauxite Company Limited.
- 3. The area within five miles of either bank of the Demerara River to the south of that part of Guyana defined in paragraph 1 of this schedule and extending as far south as the junction of the Hibibia River with the Demerara River.
- 4. (i) The area within five miles of either bank of the Essequibo River to the south of that part of Guyana defined in paragraph 1 of this schedule and extending as far south as the southern boundary of the Village District of Bartica.
  - (ii) All the islands in the Essequibo River, north of the Village District of Bartica.
