THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES
ORDINANCE
(Chapter 179)

UNDER SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN THE EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Over-head tank) (Plantation Rome) Order, 1969.
2. The proposed construction of an overhead water tank on the land described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or of part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A portion of land being part of Plantation Rome situate on the right bank of the Demerara River, in the county of Demerara, Guyana, and commencing at a point 62.0 feet from the intersection of the East Bank Public Road and the road in Plantation Rome leading to Shell Antilles Limited, on a bearing of 334° (Magnetic) and extending in a direction N 268° (Magnetic) for a distance of 136.4 feet, thence in a direction N 30° (Magnetic) for a distance of 113.0 feet, thence in a direction N 114° (Magnetic) for a distance of 114.4 feet, thence in a direction 209° (Magnetic) for a distance of 49.4 feet back to the point of commencement.
