ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 34 of 1958)

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) Amendment (No. 3) Order, 1969 and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963* and all amendments thereto.
2. The first schedule to the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1969** is hereby further amended —
 - (a) by the addition to Part A thereof of the number 13 and the article of foodstuff carrots, with the particulars set out against them as specified in Part A of the schedule to this Order; and
 - (b) by the addition to Part B thereof, of the number 13 and the article of foodstuff carrots, with the particulars set out against them, as specified in Part B of the schedule to this Order.
3. This Order shall come into operation forthwith.
