THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE, (Chapter 71).

UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE PUBLIC OFFICERS (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited the Barker (Transfer of Insurance Policies) Order, 1969.
- 2. It is hereby declared that the Public Officers (Insurance) Ordinance shall cease to apply to the two policies of insurance, No. 13763 effected with Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Company and No. 3755 effected with Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society Limited, on the life of William Adolphus Barker in favour of the Financial Secretary, and the Minister responsible for Finance is hereby directed to transfer the said policies of insurance to the said William Adolphus Barker and his wife, Matilda Melvina Barker and to pay over to them the proceeds of those policies of insurance and any increases thereon.
