ORDER

MADE UNDER

**THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 179).**

WHEREAS by Order No. 58 of 1968 made on 16th December, 1968, the proposed construction of a Multilateral School on the land described in the schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Ordinance;

AND WHEREAS by the said Order the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer, together with his agents, servants or workmen was authorised under section 4 of the Ordinance aforesaid to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Ordinance aforesaid, the report of the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer and a plan of the land to be acquired have been laid before the Governor-General;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6 of the Ordinance aforesaid, it is hereby declared that the land described in the schedule to this Order is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Multilateral School, Mahaica) Order, 1969.

SCHEDULE

A piece of land, being part of Plantations Wilhelmina and Bygeval situate on the right bank of the Mahaica River in the County of Demerara, the said piece of land containing an area of 14.06369 acres, shown, defined and bordered in red on Plan No. 13253 by Victor Winston Ross, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 2nd May, 1969 and deposited in the Lands and Mines Department on 8th May, 1969.
