THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, (Chapter 191).

UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:---

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Variation of Boundaries of District No. 1, Essequibo Coast) Order, 1969.

2. The northern, western and southern boundaries of District No. 1 Essequibo Coast, as set out in the Schedule to the Sea Defence Ordinance, are hereby varied by the substitution therefor of the boundaries set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

On the north by the Cozier Canal from its junction with the Atlantic Ocean thence in a south westerly direction to its junction, 0.7 miles east of the Pomeroon River, with an unnamed canal.

On the west by an unnamed canal from its junction with the Cozier canal, thence in a south easterly direction to the junction, 0.7 miles east of the Public Road, of the prolongation of the unnamed canal and the Somerset and Berks Main Canal, thence in a south westerly direction along the Somerset and Berks Main Canal to its junction with the Tapakuma Main Canal, thence in a south easterly direction along the Tapakuma Main Canal to its junction with the northern boundary of Plantation Alliance, thence along the back boundaries of the estates from Plantation Alliance to Plantation Onderneeming.

On the south by the southern boundary of Plantaion Onderneeming.
