THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, (No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958 AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Sugar) (Industrial Prices) Order, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order and all amendments thereto.
 - 2. In this Order —

"manufacturer" means a person (including any other person acting on his behalf) who purchases "Crystal White" sugar in Guyana at any one time in a quantity of not less than one hundred-weight for use in the manufacturing therein of goods for his business.

- 3. (1) In the Principal Order any reference to the term "Colony White" in relation to the article "sugar" shall be construed as including a reference to "Crystal White".
- (2) Purchases of "Crystal White" sugar by a manufacturer shall only be made from a producer thereof and for the purpose of such purchases the provisions of the first schedule to the Principal Order in relation to the producer's price for that article shall be construed as if there were substituted for those provisions, the respective provisions of the schedule to this Order.
