## ORDER

## MADE UNDER

## THE MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COUNCILS ACT, 196\%.

(No. 24 of 1969).

## UNDFR SECTION 33 OF THE MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COINCILS ACT, 1969, IT IS HEREBY ORIDFRED BY THE MINISTER AS FOLLOWS:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Sheet Anchor/Cumberland Local Government District (Constitution) Order, 1970.
2. That portion of Guyana in the county of Berbice, the bomdaries of which are set out in the schedule, is hereby established as a local government district to be known by the name of "the Sheet Anchor/Cumberland L.ocal Government District", hereinafter referred to as "the district".
3. The district council for the district shall have the name of "The Sheet Anchor/Cumberland District Council", hereinafter referred to as "the District Council", and shall consist of fifteen councillors.
4. The District Council may, in each year, appropriate out of its funds a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars to be placed at the disposall of the Chairman payable in equal instalments at the end of each quarter of the year.
5. The District Council shall appoint and at all times maintain a Finance Committee and a Works Comunittee as Standing Committees.
6. There shall be a Superineendent of Works for the District Council.
7. The District Council shall have power to do all or any of the things specified in section 301 of the Act excent the things specified in paragraphs (11), (12), (22) and (26) thereof.

## BOUNDARIES OF THE SHEET ANCHOR/CUMBERI.AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISTRICT -

Being all that area situate in the County of Bierbice and bounded as follows -..
On the North - by the Atlantic Ocean.
On the South - by the Canje River and the southern boundaries of No. 2 or Cumberland and No. 6 or Prospect.

On the East - by the eastern boundary of Palmyra and the northern and eastern boundaries of Prospect.

On the West - by the Berbice River.
