## ORDER

Made Under

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE  
(Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Exemption from Import Duties) Order, 1970.

2. Item 27 of Part III of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects —

- (a) by the insertion as paragraph (18) of the following paragraph —  
“(18) Glass which the Comptroller is satisfied is solely for use in the manufacture of louvre blades”;
- (b) by the addition thereto of the following paragraph —  
“(40) Mild-steel and mild-steel galvanised wire which the Comptroller is satisfied are solely for use in the manufacture of welded reinforcement concrete mesh and welded galvanised netting.  
(41) Galvanised wire which the Comptroller is satisfied is solely for use in the manufacture of barbed wire.  
(42) Sodium saccharin which the Comptroller is satisfied is solely for use in the manufacture of dentifrices.  
(43) Steel wire which the Comptroller is satisfied is solely for use in the manufacture of nails.”
