THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 63).

UNDER SECTION 6(2) OF THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ORDINANCE, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Old Age Pensions (Appeal Boards) Order, 1971 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 10th September, 1970.

2. An Old Age Pension Appeal Board is hereby established for each of the counties of Guyana for the purpose of hearing appeals from the decisions of any appropriate authority refusing the claims of persons for pensions.

3. The Appeal Boards shall each consist of a Chairman and two members, to be appointed by notice published in the Gazette.

4. The Old Age Pensions (Appeal Board) Order is hereby revoked.
