THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, THE FOLLOWING ORDER IS HEREBY MADE:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Cigarettes) Order, 1971, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1963.*

2. The maximum prices at which the cigarettes described by the respective brand names listed in the first column of the schedule shall be sold by retail, shall be the respective prices set out in relation to such brand names in the second column of the said schedule.

Diamond	24c. per packet of 10 cigarettes.
Texas 99	14c. per packet of 10 cigarettes.
