THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1969,* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 16) Order, 1971.

2. Part A of the first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended—

- (a) by the substitution for the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, of that Part against the articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and respectively numbered, 1(a) (iii) (Butter, table, in cases of 48 tins), 1(b) (i) (Butter, cooking, Australian), 21 (Potatoes), 23 (Onions), of the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns of Part A of the Schedule to this Order against the same articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and of the said respective numbers

3. Part B of the first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended—

- (a) by the substitution for the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, of that Part against the articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and respectively 1(a) (Butter, Table, in tins of 1 lb.), 1(b) (i) (Butter, Cooking, Australian), 21 (Potatoes) and 23 (Onions), of the particulars appearing in the third, fourth and fifth columns of Part B of the Schedule to this Order against the same articles of foodstuff mentioned in the second column thereof and of the said respective numbers.
