THE MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COUNCILS ACT 1969 (No. 24 of 1969)

UNDER SECTION 206(3) OF THE MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COUNCILS ACT, 1969, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

WHEREAS the Plaisance-Industry District Council was authorised to fix the rate percentage for its rating area for the rating period 1st January, 1972 to 31st December. 1972, not later than 29th February 1972;

AND WHEREAS the rate percentage was fixed and the said Council has by virtue of section 56(3) of the Act rescinded its decision and has fixed a reduced rate percentage;

AND WHEREAS I am satisfied that it is impracticable for the said Council to comply with the provisions of section 206(1) of the Act (which require a council to fix the percentage of a general rate for a rating area not later than the day preceding the commencement of the rating period):

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section 206(3) of the Act, I hereby order that the said council shall fix the percentage of a general rate for its rating area not later than the 31st August, 1972.

This Order may be cited as the Plaisance-Industry District Council (Variation of Date for Rating) Order 1972.
