## ORDER

Made Under

THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE  
(Chapter 30)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY PART II OF THE FOURTH SCHEDULE TO THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Admission) Order 1973, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 23rd September, 1972.

2. The Commonwealth territories in which persons have been required under section 4 of the Ordinance before the enactment of the Law Revision Act 1972 -

- (a) to be called to the Bar to practise as barristers; or
- (b) to be admitted as solicitors or enrolled as law agents to practise.

as solicitors in the Supreme Court of Judicature, are hereby designated for the purposes of Part II of the Fourth Schedule to the Ordinance.
