THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Ascertainment, Determination and Suitability for Drainage) Order, 1973.

2. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area or any part thereof, described in the schedule is suitable for and will be benefitted by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.

3. The Daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the "The Daily Chronicle" and "The Guyana Graphic."

SCHEDULE

That area of land situated between the Demerara and Mahaicony River and bounded as follows -

On the North - By mean high water mark of the Atlantic Ocean commencing from its location on the right bank of the Demerara River at its northern mostly east along the said mean high water mark where it intersects the coast to its inter-section with the prolongation of the Watershed line between the Mahaica and Mahaicony Rivers.

On the South - By the Watersheds between the Mahaica and Bamia Rivers and the Moblissa and Bamia Rivers,

commencing from the intersection of the Mahaica/Mahaicony Watershed and the Mahaica/Bamia Watershed, and extending west along the Mahaica/Bamia Watershed to its intersection with Watershed, thence west along the said Bamia/Boblissa Watershed to its intersection with the centre lines of the Soesdyke/Linden Highway.

On the East By the Mahaica/Mahaicony Watershed commencing from the intersection of the prolongation of the said Watershed line and mean high water mark of the Atlantic Ocean and extending south along the said Mahaica/Mahaicony Watershed to its intersection with the Bamia/Mahaica Watershed.

On the West By the centre line of the Soesdyke/Linden Highway and mean high water mark of the Demerara River. Commencing from the intersection of the centre line of the Soesdyke/Linden Highway and the Mo-blissa/Bamia River Watershed and extending north along the centre line of the said Soesdyke/Linden Highway to the intersection to the prolongation of its centre line with mean high water mark on the right bank of the Demerara River at Soesdyke, East Bank Demerara, thence along mean high water mark along the right bank of the Demerara River back to the point of commencement at the northern most extremity of the right bank of the said Demerara River.
