scribed in the First Schodule to the Custome Ordinance, Chapter
309 and specified in the General Provisions to Part I thereof
as being based on the Brussels Nomenclature and the Standard
International Trade Classification, Revised. The prefix "Ex"

comprise only part of the iteas covered by those classification
numbere in Part I of the First Schodule to the Customs Ordinance
